- i. To assess requirement of additional enrollment and update centres and ensuring availability of enrollment centres in uncovered areas.
- ii. To ensure Aadhaar saturation in all age groups and mandatory biometric updation of children.
- iii. To ensure establishment of District/Sub-District/Block level ASKs by UIDAI, State/UT Registrar and CSC e-Gov.
- iv. To ensure Implementation of Aadhaar linked Birth Registration (ALBR).
- v. To ensure progress in mobile update in Aadhaar.
- vi. To enhance usage of Aadhaar in various Schemes and related issues.
- vii. To monitor fraudulent activities related to Aadhaar.



- viii. To monitor activities at Aadhaar Enrollment Centres and compliance of related CRMs and grievances.
- ix. Any other issues as approved by the Chairman.
